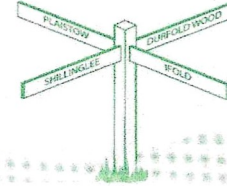

What are the main activities of your Group / Organisation?

To encourage the interest of the public in the patients and staff, and to support the work of the Chichester hospitals by means of voluntary service

Describe the project for which funding is required. Please include the projected timescale and the number of Plaistow and Ifold Parish Council residents who will benefit from the project:

The charity will use any grant money to help fund new medical equipment for St. Richard's Hospital, Chichester. Over the past year, the charity has financed a 3D camera system and ICG fluorescence imaging system equipment to aide with colorectal surgery, costing £84,686.84.



Anyone in the parish of Plaistow and Ifold who requires medical treatment at St. Richard's Hospital may benefit from the projects the charity finances.

Amount of grant requested:

£50.00

What is the total cost of the project?

The charity finances several projects. Where staff from St Richard's Hospital apply for funding for capital projects, the charity will agree to provide funding where the charity has sufficient in unrestricted funds to meet the requirements.

The current level of Reserves held:

As of 30 September 2023, the charity holds £1,276,723 across several bank accounts, of which £50,614 are restricted funds, and £725,932 has been designated for a potential significant capital investment project for St. Richard's Hospital.

What is the Applicant's policy for use of those Reserves?

Staff members make bid applications for capital investments projects. Where the charity holds sufficient unrestricted and undesignated funds to fund the project, and the project meets the charitable objects of the charity, the trustees will agree to finance the project. Projects are reviewed on a first come first served basis at each trustees' meeting.

Do you have funding from other authorities / organisations?

None. The charity receives most of its funding from donations and legacies from the public, and from running the gift shop in the hospital the charity runs with the help of volunteers. The charity is also hoping to re-introduce a volunteer-run trolley service on the wards of the hospital.

Have any fundraising activities been arranged by you?

The charity runs the gift shop in the hospital with the help of volunteers. The charity is also hoping to re-introduce a volunteer-run trolley service on the wards of the hospital.

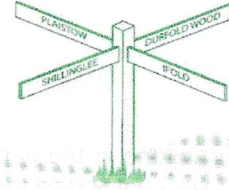
