Plaistow and Ifold Parish Council considered this application at its meeting on 29th November.

The Council supports the recommendations of the Parish Tree Warden and objects to the application for the following reasons.

The tree is subject to a TPO, although the Applicant did not answer this question correctly within the submitted application. Consequently, more evidence should be provided to justify felling the tree.

The tree has lost an amount of bark at the bottom, particularly at the back and there are no signs of Honey Fungus; (there are no back threads normally associated with Honey Fungus and the brown toadstools in close proximity do not have the rings beneath the cap normally associated with Honey Fungus). Therefore, the actual nature of the fungus should be correctly established.

The tree is still in good leaf and except for the bark loss does not look to be in decline.

The Parish Council would support pruning the tree back to previous points.
