What is the accredited marshal scheme?

The 'STOP – Cycle Race' sign is a new traffic management sign developed by the Department of Transport in collaboration with British Cycling, to safely control the movement of traffic at bike races in your local area.

What does this mean?

In connection with Section 36(1) of the 1988 Road Traffic Act, the 'Stop – Cycle Race' sign gives a British Cycling trained marshal the legal power to stop and hold traffic for brief durations on a British Cycling registered road race. This helps to:

- improve the safety of road races
- minimise the inconvenience to all road users
- give advance warning of road race activity
