## Comment on Applicant's Equestrian Centre Report (the Report)

The Report's assessment of local facilities is inaccurate as it fails to mention several local competition centers and mentions none of the excellent local rehabilitation venues.

- In the Applicant's "Map of Existing Supply", (Para 3.11, P.8) they **omit to include 5 venues** which are within an hour's drive of Crouchlands Farm. In total, there are **at least 12 competition venues within an hour's drive** that are regularly used. Please refer to the Table below on page 2.
- A notable feature of all 12 existing venues is their proximity to A roads giving easy access, which is essential for large Horseboxes given their size and maneuverability. Crouchlands Farm is not close to A roads any A roads are over 5 miles away; after which small rural roads are required to reach the venue.
- The "Map of Existing Supply" (Para 3.11, P.8) also fails to list venues that are rehab only such as Equine Aqua Training in The Haven (8 miles away); Sussex Equine Hospital (13 miles) and Liphook Equine Hospital (16 miles), which is one of the largest in the UK. In addition, many people prefer to book Chiropractor, Physio, massage etc. to come to where the horse is stabled, as this is better for the horse. They only travel for something like the aqua treadmill and in that case choose the one nearby and go typically once a week for an hour.
- The report details several Closed Venues (Para 4.1, P9): Several listed have been closed for many years e.g., Stilemans, Shamley Green, Stocklands. These have all been closed for over 35+ years. Priory is still used for some dressage and pony club events and so is not completely closed. Royal Leisure is now the superb facility in Hascombe and is definitely not closed.
- The Report asserts at para 4.2.2, P. 12 that "top riders are moving abroad to have access to consistently better facilities, and conversely, riders from abroad are not coming to the UK in such numbers to compete due to these falling standards". This may be true in some parts of the UK, but in this area, there are many top riders and overseas riders basing themselves here: Swain & Price form New Zealand; Burton & McNab from Australia; Constantin (Tintin) Van Rijckevorsel from Belgium and many top British riders.
- The Applicant's proposal does not appear to have the level of spectator seating for the outdoor arena (EQUESTRIAN CENTRE LANDSCAPE LAYOUT) that would be typically associated with a venue at this level, aspiring to be a "World Class facility", to "rival those available in Europe" and to attract "top riders". Both Hickstead and Ardingly have outdoor arena grandstands/pavilions. Both venues are in West Sussex.

The Applicant's proposal does not appear to have the level of spectator seating for the outdoor arena that would be typically associated with a venue at this level and does not appear to be compatible with the Applicant's assertion that the Site will be a "World Class facility", to "rival those available in Europe" and to attract "top riders". Concern is that future proposals will follow, to increase the level of spectator seating for the outdoor arena, to allow the centre to be commercially viable.

• To do so would require an additional large structure adjacent to the outdoor arena
