If you are willing to help, please tick any of the areas listed below that you may be able to assist with in the event of a major incident. A detailed Emergency Plan is to be drawn up and all those potential responders will be provided details of how the plan will operate and managed. Such areas may include:

Manual / Communications

Community Assistance

To make available:

To assist with the dissemination of information and communication arrangements to the residents and third parties

Tractor / Trailer

Check up on vulnerable residents

4X4 Vehicle

Assist with delivering items to residents

Generators

To collect and deliver prescriptions

Chain Saw

To provide transport to take to a safe location

Two Way radios / other communication methods

To provide hot meals to vulnerable residents

Basic equipment such as shovels etc.

To provide temporary accommodation in extreme need

Use of land, services or other facilities

Provide any other assistance they may be needed

The above list is not exhaustive and will be dependent on the nature of the emergency that arises.

The Parish Council **can only enact** an **Emergency Plan** with the assistance of the **local community** and would **ask for your support**.
