I am writing to say that we desperately need a Bus Shelter in plaistow. Kirdford has 2, Loxwood has 1, so I am begging you to put one in plaistow

I am writing to ask you, as Chairman of Plaistow and Ifold Parish Council, to please consider the provision of a bus shelter, for those of us who use the bus services at Plaistow, such as they are.

There was a bus shelter originally, which I remember well. But it was vandalised, and damaged beyond repair.. I write as an 83-year old, resident here since 1961.
