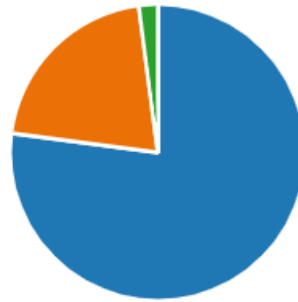

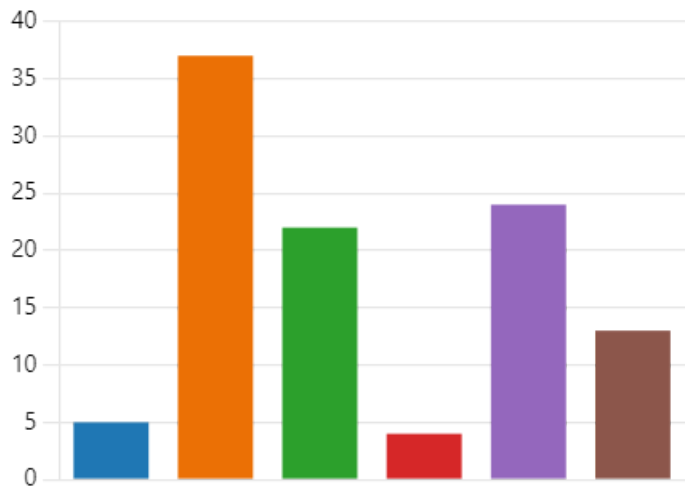

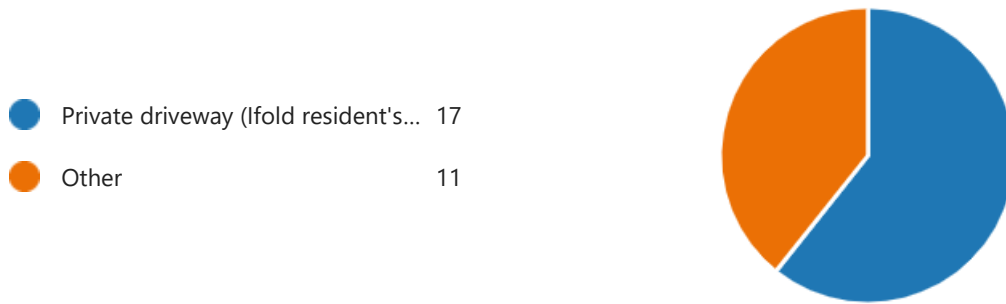

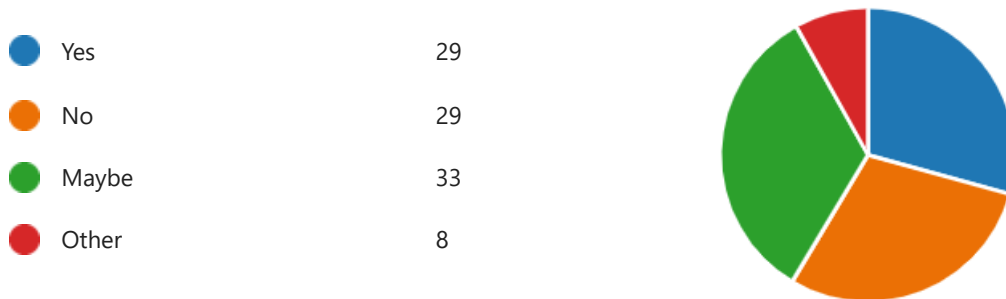

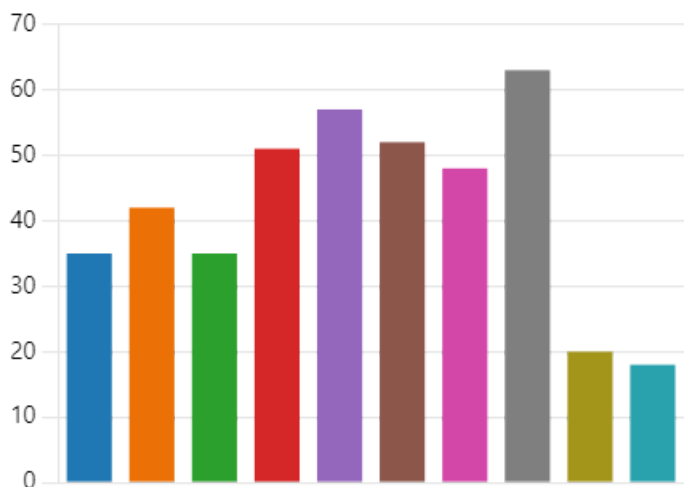

8. Which types of equipment would you like the Parish Council to consider installing in the area?

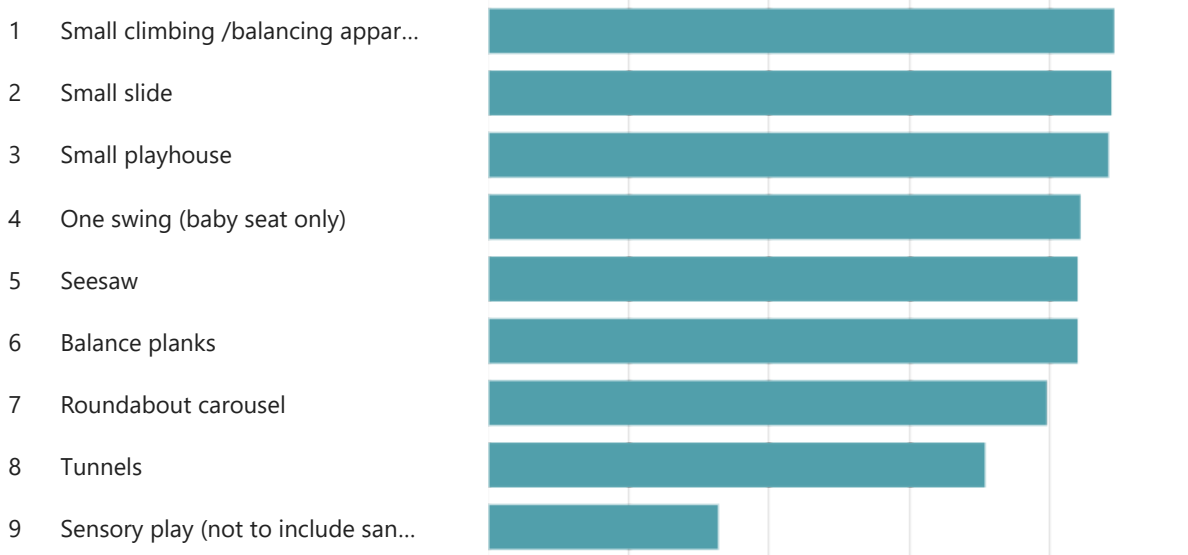

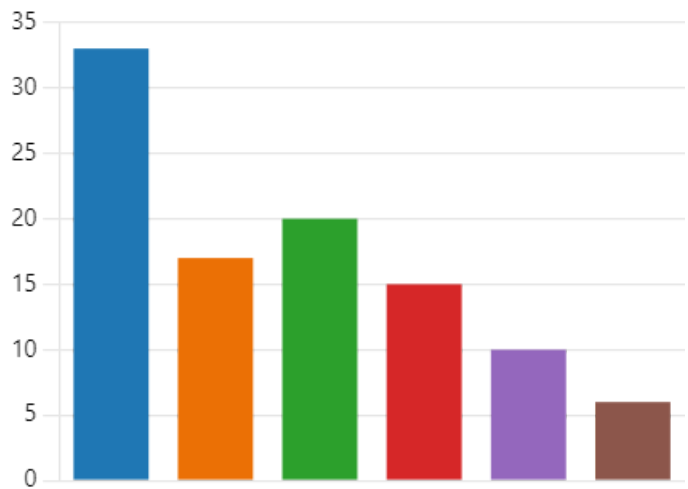
