Severe Highways Flooding Plaistow Rd Ifold. West Sussex

Plaistow and Ifold Parish Council would ask that an investigation is carried out to determine the reason for the severe flooding that occurs in times of heavy rainfall along the Plaistow Rd. There are two locations where traffic passage almost becomes completely obstructed due to the depth of the water and is only saved as there is a slight gradient directing water off the road into nearby gardens.

The ditches in that area have not been maintained well and also this problem could be caused by drain/culvert blockages. Could this be determined and if ditches are the problem the Parish Council would be grateful if you would enforce maintenance via your Riparian Law enforcement powers.
