PRECEPT 25/26 A parish council precept is the amount of money a parish council raises from taxpayers through the council tax. The Parish Council set the Parish precept requirement at it's meeting on 15th January 2025 and has sent this off to Chichester District Council for approval. The precept requested remains the same as for the current year at £120,000. After heavy expenditure over the last few years, mainly in connection with responding to the Crouchlands Planning applications and appeals, but also repaying a loan taken out to refurbish Lady Hope Playpark which is now drawing to an end, the Parish Council Finances are once again healthy. The Parish Council continues to apply for grants and funding where possible.
