Town Police Clauses Act 1847, Section 21

Order for the Prevention of Obstruction, Etc.

<u>W H E R E A S</u> during certain hours on 24 July 2022, Loxwood Road, Plaistow – from the junction with The Street/Dunsfold Road with Common House Road (road joining Loxwood Road to The Street/Rumbolds Lane/Rickman's Lane), will be thronged and liable to be obstructed, Chichester District Council pursuant to the powers conferred by Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act, 1847, do <u>HEREBY ORDER</u> and <u>DIRECT</u> that for the purpose of preventing obstruction in the said street on the said day, the following Regulations shall be observed:-

- (1) The said street shall be closed to all vehicular traffic including pedal cycles, between the hours of 10.00am and 14.00pm.
- (2) Drivers wishing to proceed in the said street shall use the alternative route indicated.
- (3) Emergency vehicles shall be granted access to the said street if required.

The penalty for infringement of the said Regulations is a fine not exceeding <u>ONE THOUSAND POUNDS (£1,000)</u>.
