Town Police Clauses Act 1847, Section 21

Order for the Prevention of Obstruction, Etc

W H E R E A S during certain hours on 24 July 2022, Loxwood Road, Plaistow – from the junction with The Street/Dunsfold Road with Common House Road (road joining Loxwood Road to The Street/Rumbolds Lane/Rickman's Lane), will be thronged and liable to be obstructed, Chichester District Council pursuant to the powers conferred by Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act, 1847, do HEREBY ORDER and DIRECT that for the purpose of preventing obstruction in the said street on the said day, the following Regulations shall be observed:-

- (1) The said street shall be closed to all vehicular traffic including pedal cycles, between the hours of 10.00am and 14.00pm.
- (2) Drivers wishing to proceed in the said street shall use the alternative route indicated.
- (3) Emergency vehicles shall be granted access to the said street if required.

The penalty for infringement of the said Regulations is a fine not exceeding ONE THOUSAND POUNDS (£1,000).
