
### PLAISTOW AND IFOLD PARISH COUNCIL

a. Oxencroft – to consider an Enforcement action update.

Members NOTED the following update from CDC: -

No enforcement notice has yet been served against the breaches identified at Oxencroft. The report is being drafted which will be signed off under the delegated process and then passed to Legal Services to progress. The Parish Council will be updated once the notice has been served. The notice will address the occupation of the land, the additional outbuildings, the earth bunds and the entrance gates.

Regarding the application for the conversion of the agricultural building to a dwellinghouse, the decision was to refuse the prior approval application. The owners have not yet lodged an appeal against the decision of the Local Planning Authority.

The appeal that has been lodged for the entrance gates at Oxencroft is in relation to the refusal of the planning application.

The Committee **RESOLVED** to write in support of the LPA's position once the appeal is listed with the Planning Inspectorate.



Re: 21/00545/EIA | TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990 | Screening Opinion under Part II Regulation 5 - Town and Country Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) (England and Wales) Regulations 2017 | Commercial and high welfare, low impact and low intensity farming activity, the gradual development of a rural enterprise centre, a rural food and retail centre, equestrian centre, and glamping site.

Site: Crouchlands Farm, Rickmans Lane, Plaistow, Billingshurst, West Sussex, RH14 OLE

Further to Plaistow and Ifold Parish Council's consideration of the Local Planning Authority's (LPA) above referred to Screening Opinion, the Parish Council respectfully wishes to highlight and correct the omission of the area's historic environment & landscape impact assessment.

The Screening Opinion does not refer to the historic environment of the area, with Grade II listed buildings on the site itself, and immediately adjacent to the road network; particularly along Foxbridge Lane and through Plaistow and Kirdford villages. These would be the main routes in and out of the proposed development and have conservation areas through which the traffic would travel. The proposed equestrian centre would impact the Crouchlands house and outbuildings, and the volume of vehicles/traffic movement created by the whole development will have an adverse impact on the historic environment on this area.

The Screening Opinion does not include a requirement for a landscape impact assessment. Although the area landscape is not designated, the Parish Council respectfully refers to the Crouchland Biogas planning inquiry, where it was clearly demonstrated that such landscape designation is not necessary for it to be an important factor. Landscape played an important part in considering this major development and was part of the LPA's position against the Biogas plant; therefore, it is not clear why the LPA has not specifically included this matter in its Screening Opinion and appears

inconsistent with its previous approach and position.

The Parish Council looks forward to receiving your position on these matters.
