- 1. On 23rd March WSALC held its annual meeting with local MPs. Some attended; others sent apologies. Notably, Gillian Keegan did not bother to reply at all. The meeting discussed
 - a. the reintroduction of sanctions for misconduct by councillors;
 - b. the reintroduction of the ability to hold meetings remotely; and
 - c. concerns over housing allocations.
- 2. The WSALC Clerks' forum will take place on 11th April and the Chairmen's forum on 12th April.
- 3. Some parishes were cut off during the recent storms. Trevor Leggo sought to persuade all PCs to have a 'resilience plan' to cover such events and pointed to good examples from Singleton and Charlton parishes.
- 4. Nicolette Pike was elected as CDALC's representative on the Chichester Harbour Conservancy. Nicolette is a parish councillor from West Wittering and solicitor specialising in planning and environmental law. Amanda Tait from Southbourne PC was elected as the deputy.
